APPLICANT CRITERIA:

To be eligible, applicants must meet the following qualifications:

- o Applicant must be a resident of any of the seven (7) counties, or member-firm areas served by AIA Rochester.
- o Applicants must be accepted and enrolled in an architecture college program for the Fall 2023 academic term. Preference will be given to students in a NAAB accredited degree program. All scholarship monies must be used towards school expenses.
- Preference will be given to members of communities historically underrepresented in the field of architecture.
- o All applications must be complete and postmarked by April 14, 2023, to be considered.

- o All material must be legible to be considered.

- 6. In a separate, sealed envelope, provide a certified copy of your high school transcript that includes a listing of your courses for the Fall and Spring of the 12th grade. Have your Guidance Counselor include a description of the curriculum and grading system used. Also, clearly indicate on the transcript "honors" or "advanced placement" courses with test scores and any courses completed from a college or university curriculum for which high school credit is earned. Place page 3 of this application in this envelope for submission.
