Directions to DoubleTree by Hilton:

- From NYS Thruway: Exit 46 to I-390N top Exit 14 (5 minutes) top of exit left on Rt. 15A, the hotel is on the right.
- From Greater Rochester International Airport: Exit airport. Turn right to merge on I-390S. Follow I390S to Exit 14B, East Henrietta Rd. At top of exit ramp at intersection, turn right onto Rt. 15A, hotel is on immediate right.

- **From the West**: Take I-490E to I-390S to Exit 14B, East Henrietta Rd. At top of ramp at the intersection, turn right onto Rt. 15A. The hotel is on the immediate right.
