OUR MISSION

AIA Rochester's mission is to promote the profession and practice of Architecture in the Greater Rochester Area. AIA Rochester is dedicated to providing its members opportunities for professional advancement, community involvement, and promoting design excellence in the built environment.

HISTORY OF THE AIA ROCHESTER CHAPTER

The Rochester Chapter of the American Institute of Architects owes its beginnings to two sources. In the early 20th century, a few Rochester architects belonged to the Central New York Chapter, which covered a broad area from the Western line of Monroe County to the Adirondacks. In 1919, they soon recognized the need for a local organization and founded the Rochester Society of Architects. The Society quietly thrived for forty years, enjoying luncheons and an annual dinner. During the Great Depression the members set up mutual help activities as they worked to survive in those hard times. Later, with the development of better communications and easier travel, the National AIA became a recognized force.

In 1962 the Society voted to become a Section of the Central New York Chapter, and members became more active in AIA affairs. Soon thereafter, it became clear that Rochester architects would benefit from becoming an independent chapter. Application was made to the National Board of the AIA for a Chapter Charter, which was granted in October, 1968. Initially, the Chapter consisted only of Monroe County, however in 1981 Wayne, Livingston, Ontario, Yates and Seneca Counties were added. In 2014 Allegany County joined our chapter.

Since then, the Chapter has grown in health and size. Nationally it boasts of one of the highest percentages of member architects in its area. Programs expanded, and a central office was established in 1971. The loyalty and dedication of its members indicates its ongoing importance to the Rochester community.

The Charter members of AIA Rochester were Hugh P. Anderson, Florence England Bishop, William C. Burwell, Michael J. Doran, James W. Gemmill, Carl F. W. Kaelber Jr., Roger F. Leaper, G. Carroll Madden, Marvin Meyer, and Myron E. Starks.





ASSOCIATE MEMBERS

Associate Members are those without architectural licenses from a U.S. Licensing authority and who are: holder of a professional degree in architecture; or employee under supervision of an architect in a professional or technical capacity related to the practice of architecture; or faculty member in a university program in architecture actively involved in research, administration, or the teaching of architecture; or holder of an architectural license or equivalent from a non-U.S. Licensing authority.

LICENSURE

There are three major components to becoming an architect:

Education

Education requirements vary by state. Check your local jurisdiction. NYS residents can refer to the Office of the Professions website: https://www.op.nysed.gov/architecture

Examination

The Architect Registration Examination® (ARE®) is a multi- division exam that assesses your knowledge and skills.

Experience

You'll need to document real-world experience through the Architectural Experience Program® (AXP®)

Licensure

Once you pass the exams and complete the experience requirement, you can register for a license. Individual states grant licenses. You can become licensed in multiple states.

Compare licensure requirements of the 54 jurisdictions to decide where to get your initial license. Typically, to maintain or renew your license, you'll need to earn continuing education credits each year.

After you have your first license you will need to change your status with AIA National from Associate to Architect. Complete the 2023 Associate to Architect Form and send it to memberservices@aia.org. Please allow three to five business days for processing. Your status in our directory will be changed at the next directory update.
